Dianella caerulea "Breeze"

Description; Free flowing, dark green foliage with exquisite sprays of soft blue flowers in spring, followed by attractive, purple berries.

Grows to ; 60cm high and similar width.

Drought Tolerant; Dianella caerulea is known as one of the most drought tolerant hardy plants available.

Position; Tolerates a wide range of soils and climactic requirements. Suited to full sun as well as shady positions.

Frost Tolerant; Able to cope well with even the cold frosts of Canberra.

Humidity & Heat Tolerant;

Able to cope with the humidity of Darwin, and the heat of inland Australia.

Low Maintenance;

Trim approximately once every 8 years. Fertilize with slow release fertilizer every spring.

'No canes' is what makes Breeze so good.

Unlike the common variety of Dianella caerulea, Breeze has no messy straw brown canes that often fall over.

Note; Breeze does not usually have canes, but its flower stems can appear cane like when first emerging. (Only for a short period)

Provides an excellent ground cover.

A great plant for mass planting.
