

Díanella caerulea "Cassa Blue"

Description; A blue "No cane Dianella caerulea with mass flowers.

This tough, drought and frost tolerant Dianella caerulea's foliage grows to approximately 40cm tall with a spread of 40cm. Its mass of baby blue flowers grow to about 55 cm in height. It is a more clumping form of Dianella caerulea rather than spreading. The flowers are followed by purple berries.

Foliage; Compact and rich blue foliage, coupled with its highly desirable size and shape, make it the ideal plant for both commercial landscape, and home garden design.

Naturally Tough; Dianella caerulea's natural toughness make this an ideal plant for mass planting.

In some ways Cassa Blue has the shape of a dwarf Phormium ,but only far tougher

Its blue colour provides great contrast in any garden or landscape design.

Position; Tolerates a wide range of soils and climactic conditions. Suited to full sun as well as partially shaded positions.

Cassa Blue is both humidity and cold tolerant.

Low Maintenance; Fertilize with slow release fertilizer every spring.
