Diplarrena moraea 'Butterfly Flag Iris'

Known as; Native Dietes

Description; Well grown plants form thick clumps, with long narrow leaves and white flowers.

This plant is native to NSW, Vic, and Tasmania. In Victoria it is often used as an alternative to Dietes and Lomandra.

Grows to; approximately 600mm high and has a spread of 350mm. It is very similar in habit and appearance to Dietes iridioides.

Position; Moraea is best in full sun, with the flowers appearing in spring and continuing until early summer

Because of their particular habit of growth, these plants make excellent specimens for use in permanent containers.

Frost Hardy ; Moraea is frost hardy and has good resistance to insect and disease attack.

Maintenance; remove dead flowers and leaves when required
Fertilize in spring.
