Lomandra longifolia "Tanika"

Description; An improved compact fine leaf form of the popular *Lomandra longifolia*. This attractive deep green selection provides a graceful, versatile plant. Tanika has an attractive yellow flower head in early spring.

Grows to; 60cms spread 60cms.

Position; Grows well in full sun and shaded positions. Will tolerate exposed and windy sites. Performs well in heavy clay or free draining soils. Tolerates heavy frost, drought, hot or humid conditions. Tanika has proven to be one of the toughest, most reliable landscape plants over the last couple of years. An ideal specimen for mass planting or garden beds and borders.

Maintenance; Very low once established. Occasionally fertilise with slow release fertilizer to maintain the lush green foliage. Remove older leaves if required, generally every three to four years. Ideal for South Australian conditions.
