



Poa poiformis "Courtney"

Description; A clumping green tussock grass.

Grows to;70cm .

Foliage; A beautiful green contrasting ornamental native grass, that when planted at 15 to 20 per square meter, will usually out compete most weeds. Growing to a height of 50cm, its fine green arching leaves add softness to any garden design.

Position; Tolerates a wide range of soils and climatic requirements. Suited to full sun, as well as shady positions. Very hardy, exhibiting excellent drought and frost tolerance. Also suitable in salt sprayed coastal positions.

Low Maintenance; Little or no maintenance required. Fertilize with slow release fertilizer to keep leaves deep blue colour. Water well until established.

Comments; Performs well on sloping sites that require erosion control. Can also be planted as a specimen. An excellent plant for roadside plantings and as a contrast plant to Kingsdale.
