



Dianella revoluta "Revelation"

Description; Revelation is a medium sized *Dianella revoluta*. Fully rounded, compact clump with interesting two tone green / blue foliage.

Grows to; 50cm width 50cm.

Foliage; Revelation puts on a show with an abundance of beautiful blue flowers from mid spring through to early summer. This is followed by purple edible berries.

Position; Tolerates a wide range of soils and climatic requirements. Suited to full sun, as well as shady positions. Very hardy, exhibiting excellent drought and frost tolerance.

Low Maintenance; Little or no maintenance required. Plant in well mulched garden. Fertilise with slow release once a year in spring. Water well until established.

Comments; *Dianella caerulea* is known as one of the most drought tolerant, adaptable Australian native plants. Revelation will spread slightly over time, however for this reason; it is good for situations that need erosion control. Its large rhizomes stabilise the soil. Good understory plant in sparse tree plantings. Good companion plant with Cassa Blue, Little Rev, Little Jess, and Tanika. Excellent erosion control plant. Good for raised areas or depressed areas. Excellent for along paths and roads, as the plant will spread slowly to the edge of the planting area.
