Grafted Grevilleas

The grafted standard Grevillea is now being used as attractive addition to gardens around South coast on Australia. The standard Grevillea is a newly produced plant that is slowly gaining popularity due to availability and exposure. The grafted Grevillea offers a stunning native alternative to other standard plants, such as roses. Along with their spectacular flowers the grafted Grevillea provide year round interest in the landscape. They provide an unusual feature that can look beautiful in a formal garden or a natural setting. With the plants size and adaptability it can be used in a small courtyard or place several in a bigger garden for a spectacular effect.



The standard Grevillea will grow in most soils and will require staking when initially planted .This plant has a less than average requirement for water once established.

They are an evergreen that came to being by grafting a Grevillea that would normally be a groundcover with the rootstock of Silky Oak; Grevilleas are known for their straightness and ability to cope with many soil types, improving its usefulness and applications. Being a grafted plant there are many types of Standard Grevillea available for example Gaudi Chaudi and Bipinadifida both renown for their excellent flower shows
